Monash Heart cardiologists have not been able to find the cause of Mrs Jobe's heartstopping moment, with no family history of heart disease, She has had a defibrillator implanted — and the gym bought one last week.

She has been given the all-clear by doctors to return to exercise, her husband and gym staff have imposed a ban for now.

"I'm looking forward to getting back to a normal life, driving and exercising, but I'm just waiting for them to be comfortable about it," she said.
